

Climathon in Lund 2020 - Food and Climate

Climathon is EIT Climate-KICs global initiative to hack solutions to climate change. Climathon will be held in over 100 cities around the world simultaneously. Climathon has been organised in Lund 2017, 2018 and 2019. In 2020 we aim to make the event larger than ever and also to hold a few events around the actual Climathon to make sure that we get the best outcome, both when it comes to solutions and interactions between different actors involved.

Food and Climate

The theme for Climathon in Lund 2020 will be Food and Climate.

What we will do in Lund

We will gather a partnership with a number of external organisations and work together with them to hack their challenges in the area of climate and food. The partners will formulate challenges and we will work on solutions to them during three different events in the autumn of 2020:

- (beginning of oktober) a half or full day event with partner representatives and LU researchers that work on solutions to the partners Challenges. This will be a "mini hackaton".
- 5/11 there will be a start meeting for Climathon. We will present the Challenges and divide the participants into groups. After this the participants can start to think about solution.
- 13/11 is the actual Climathon date.

Whats the point?

We think that we will achieve a number of positive outcomes from these activities:

- Help solve challenges regarding climate and food.
- Increase and deepen the cooperation between science and business.
- Give participants a deepened knowledge in how to develop ideas and solutions to complex problems.
- Give participants a deepened knowledge in how to develop ideas and solutions into concrete projects.
- Introduce students to potential employers and employers to potential employees.
- Spread inspiration, good spirit and joy.
